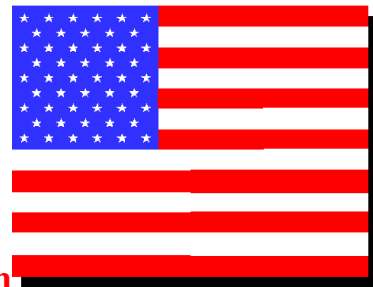

Buffalo EA: Navy calls, Buffalo Execs member firm **Indoor Air Professionals** answers: After a fire broke out on the USS George Washington aircraft carrier last month, the vessel's ventilation systems needed cleaning up. BEA member Indoor Air Professionals, got the call. A dozen of its indoor air technicians are working on the carrier in San Diego. The Nimitz class, nuclear-powered carrier was en route from Virginia to its new home port in Yokosuka, Japan, when the fire occurred. The carrier was already scheduled to stop in California and is undergoing emergency repairs there. The Navy wants to complete the work as soon as possible so that the vessel can continue on to Japan, where it will replace the USS Kitty Hawk.

About half the IAP technicians working on the USS George Washington are from the company's Lancaster office, and about half are from its San Diego office.

In the old days (when Las Vegas was 300,000 population and you could drive across town in 15 minutes) we used to get 125-150 people. Now we are lucky if we get 25% of the membership.
